The logo

Congress logo

The master congress logo can be used on congress-related materials.

The master logo should always be used responsibly and appropriately on all congress-related materials, complying fully with the guidance provided in this toolkit. Please ensure that the logo is not used to express an affiliation with any unauthorised parties or to portray ESOT in a negative manner.

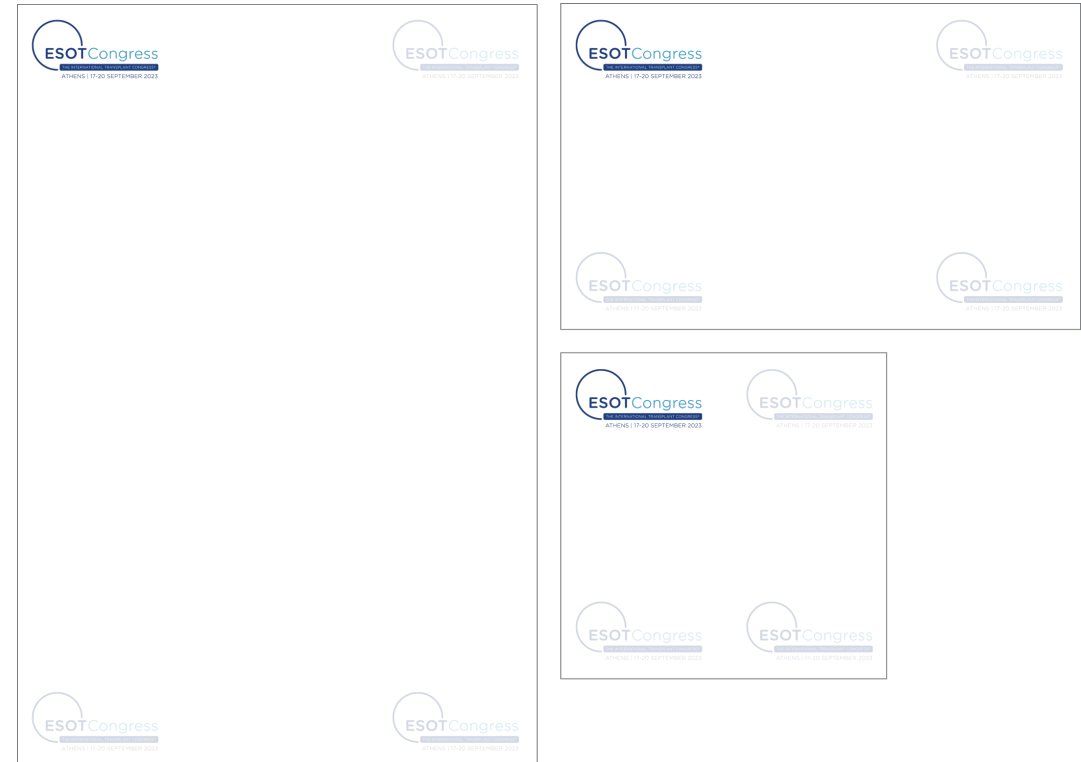
Logo placement

Regardless of communication size or dimension, the logo can be placed in four locations.

Please keep in mind the logo exclusion zone when placing the logo in a corner.

In order of preference the placement options are:

- Top left corner
- Top right corner
- Bottom left corner
- Bottom right corner



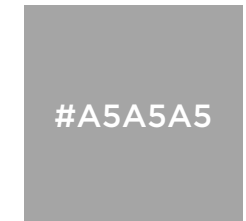
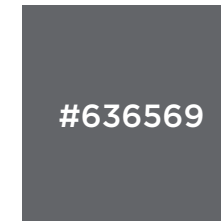
Colour codes

ESOT has a range of colours that are used to align with the brand guidelines.

These colours can be used across any congress-related materials. Utilise the hex codes shown on the right hand side of this page to create the colours in digital documents, images and assets.

Primary colours

Our primary colour palette is derived from the logo elements, using blue as a consistent signature colour for all ESOT communications. The blue colour is supported by a neutral grey colour so we can have balance in our communications.



Secondary colours

A secondary palette supports our primary colours to help with navigation, charts and illustrations. When producing charts and graphs you should use blue or grey colours first but these additional colours are important to offer contrast and clarity. The secondary colours have been selected to complement the primary palette.

Additional icons

Icons can be used alongside our charts and graphs to simply represent information at a glance.

ESOT has two styles of icon; linear and solid. Our linear icons reflect the hand drawn outlines in our logo. The linear style should be used where more scientific detail is required.

We use a solid, filled icon for non scientific content such as the website and infographics. The solid icons can be coloured using any of our brand colours.
